

How to Make a Pool Noodle Winter or Christmas Candle

Pick up a pool noodle to make the coolest candle display! The best part is that they're so easy to make and cost next to nothing!



SUPPLIES needed for a Pool Noodle Christmas Candle

Dollar Tree Pool Noodle

Kilz Primer

Craft Knife

Tea Light Candles (battery-operated)

White Paint

Ribbon

Hot Glue Gun



Step 1. Use a craft knife or x-acto knife to cut the pool noodle to the size that you want. I cut 3 in different sizes so I could stagger them.



STEP 2. Place a battery-operated tea light on top of one of the pool noodles to use it as a template for cutting. Use your craft knife to cut a large enough hole to fit the candle.



STEP 3. Place each of the 3 battery-operated candles into the pool noodle to ensure they fit. Make any adjustments as needed.





STEP 5. Use a chip brush and white paint to paint the candle. Be sure to cover the entire candle. Let dry.



STEP 6. Use your hot glue gun to create faux wax running down the top of each candle.



STEP 7. Use your hot glue gun to add a pretty ribbon to the bottom of each candle.
