CHAPTER ONE

SILENCE IS A WOMAN'S BEST FRIEND

Immediately after a breakup the hardest part is controlling your emotions. Which is why silence is golden...it camouflages your emotions. It's perfectly fine to fall to pieces... *just not in front of Mr. Ex.* Stay calm, grounded, don't cry, beg, plead or grovel for him to take you back. A strong woman knows how to take care of her and the life that she has created. More importantly, she knows her mind. She doesn't allow drama in her life. And she doesn't allow a man to make her messy. She knows her value and self-worth and has the confidence and self-esteem to back it up. She's with a man because she *wants* to be, not because she *needs* to be. She knows in advance if a man walks out of her life, it's his loss. She acknowledges having a man around is a bonus, not a necessity and is perfectly capable of taking care of herself without one. And men are attracted to women that possess the ability to walk away from a relationship as bees are to honey.

When you immediately spring into fix it mode trying to repair a relationship, you're falling for his game. He's expecting you to call and text him at all hours of the day and night professing your undying love. This is what the "hard to get man" is accustomed to. And guess what? He's losing respect for you each time he sees your name pop up on his phone. He's thinking he has a front row seat to the best drama show on earth and you're the star of the show. Your actions are telling him he won't have to break a sweat to win you back because you're doing all of the hard work for him.

Too many women fall in love and without realizing it unknowingly begin to give too much of themselves in the process. Maybe you were hard to get in the beginning, let him chase you like a lion chases its prey and then...he caught you. Maybe your only fault is being too nice and too available. And men believe women that are too nice and too available are not only thirsty for love but are completely dehydrated. Most women don't even realize they're doing this until it's too late.

It's only natural to want to make the man you love happy. But when you give too much of yourself is when a relationship unravels. You've lost his interest. You're no longer the sexy siren that caught his attention. You became the woman that gave too freely, arranged her life around his, answered the phone when it rang, and gave it your all only to be left in shock when he became bored, or met someone else who provides him with the thrill of the chase. It's a vicious never-ending cycle.

HOW TO PREVENT A MAN FROM LOSING INTEREST

If you never lose interest in yourself chances are he'll never lose interest in you. By setting your standards so high that he constantly has to work to meet them. By knowing your boundaries and by refusing to accept any bad behavior. *By respecting yourself so much he'll put you right where you belong...on a pedestal.* By never allowing him to believe, you've been caught.

Once they get you, they don't need to prove anything so they move on to the next woman who thinks they're handsome, smart, charming and perfect. When you have other things going on in your life besides him, he doesn't feel suffocated or chained to tree, so always strive to keep your life a fulfilled one. You should view a man as a topping to an already great dessert. The dessert is fine on its own but it's always a bit sweeter with all the extras.

EMAILS, TEXT MESSAGES, AND SOCIAL MEDIA

Technology has made it nearly impossible for women to remain a little mysterious and even harder on women to handle a breakup, because there are simply too many avenues of communication. Keyboards are readily available right at your delicate fingertips to express emotions you feel the need to get off your chest...immediately! And it's true nobody can text faster than a pissed off woman.

Women are mostly defined as creatures of habit. Throw an unexpected breakup in the mix and you fall to pieces. While you are left devastated over the breakup, Mr. Ex is one-step ahead of you. He's had plenty of time to plan and prepare his exit well in advance of informing you of his decision to do so. That's why he's handling the breakup like a champ... he's had ample time to prepare himself mentally and to detach himself emotionally.

WHY WOMEN LOSE THE BATTLE OF THE BREAKUP

Because women fall apart when they're not mentally prepared and are caught off guard... *just as if you were notified about a loved one's death*. It shocks you! By the time your brain has registered exactly what has transpired, you immediately want to get everything out in the open. This is also a perfect example of what not to do.

By going silent immediately after a breakup you handle it the right way from the beginning. *No Contact* accomplishes two goals: The first is to recover from the breakup and move on to Mr. Right, which gives you an opportunity to begin your life with a fresh new start. It also tells Mr. Ex that you are secure with who you are, and perfectly competent enough to handle your own life.

The second is to give Mr. Ex space and time so that he has ample opportunity to wonder what you are thinking. By controlling your emotions, you regain your power from the start by making the decision to not initiate any form of contact. *No contact* hides the fact that you may be falling apart. Regardless of your intent starting *No Contact* accomplishes either goal you set.

There's no need to make an announcement to the world, or to Mr. Ex for that matter that you have no intention of speaking with him again. Starting *No Contact* means you are quietly taking a step back and will make no effort whatsoever to contact him during this time.

This includes but is not limited to phone calls, text messages, running into Mr. Ex, and definitely no ex sex! It means you are going to accept the breakup for what is regardless if you have closure or not and quietly vanish from radar. Women that truly understand their self-worth don't pursue men. And a man won't value you if immediately go into overdrive to fix a relationship after a breakup.

Just make an agreement with yourself that you will not initiate any form of contact whatsoever. If you believe anything about yourself believe that you're worth a damn phone call! If you've text, called, emailed him or attempted to reach out to him by any form of communication stop now before any further

damage is done.

NO DAMAGE CONTROL REQUIRED

You need not offer any

apology, explanation or excuse for your behavior. You were going through an emotional time which is only to be expected. It only shows you loved him. By going silent he'll slowly forget about all of the negative thoughts and replace them with positives ones.

Oprah Winfrey once said, "Lots of people want to ride with you in the limo, but what you want is someone who will take the bus with you when the limo breaks down." The same can be applied when it comes to relationships. Don't you want a man that can handle not only the good times, but the bad times, too? Rest assured, if he only wants you during the good times, you can be guaranteed he won't be there for you during the bad times. There is a reason why marriage yows

include "for better or for worse." Even if you acted in a way that you are not so proud of a man that truly loves, cares for you and adores you will be more than willing to handle you with delicate gloves when signs of trouble arise. Men are problem solvers by nature. If they want to fix it

the true alpha male won't miss a beat coming up with solutions to fix a problem. If he wants you he'll find a way to solve a problem come hell or high water. If he wants you there is nothing that can or will stand in his way of getting you. And if he can't handle you on your bad days, then understand he's not worthy of you on your good ones. Cut this one loose, fast.

TO MAKE HIM MISS YOU

While you were in a relationship with Mr. Ex, he grew accustom to the attention you gave him. There were perks he received from you because the two of you were in an exclusive committed relationship, which included being available to him, answering his calls, text messages, meeting him for dinner and of course great mind-blowing sex.

Now that you're no longer in an exclusive committed relationship the only way to make him miss what he had is to make him feel your absence from his life. Only when you make him feel the void will he get serious about getting you back and keeping you all to himself. If you stay in contact with him from the beginning of the breakup you fail to make him feel the loss of your presence in his life. Just like a death.

I realize ignoring him goes against every fiber of your being, but now more than ever you must show restraint and self-control. When he calls you'll want to respond with lightning speed, but do nothing that gives him the impression you are sitting on pins and needles waiting on his call or text. Let his call go straight to voicemail. Let it be several hours or days before you respond.

If he sends a text, such as "This weather is beautiful," don't respond. It requires no answer. It's a nothing text and requires a nothing response. If he declares by text he "misses you" ignore that as well. He is just stating he misses you; he's not providing you with a plan which puts you both back together. He's not asking for a dinner date. He's not giving you an explanation that brings you comfort and eases your mind. Don't give him a reward just because he's capable of typing words that form a sentence on a keypad. Unless this is a long distance relationship, I bet he could jump in his car and be next to you within twenty-five minutes, if he missed you that much. Show him the silent treatment until he's knocking on your door, making grand gestures and more importantly providing you with a plan that gives you what you need.

If a reconciliation is in the future you have to make him start over... as in from the beginning. He's has to work to get the relationship back to what it was before he sailed it off course. *Yes*, that's right. Let the chase begin. Until

then... You're busy with your new life!

By not allowing him to know where you are and what you are thinking you slowly plant the seeds of insecurity and rejection he has made you feel right back to him. And to accomplish this you have to make him feel you are no longer his.

You may say that you believe this is playing games and you're not one to play games. Well, how's that working for you? In a perfect world there would be no need, but this isn't a perfect world. Chances are he has been playing games with you for months, years or longer. Men live for the thrill of the chase. Once he gets you, chances are he may get bored and start chasing someone else. It's a never-ending game, so learn how to play it and have fun in the process.

Men don't realize women don't play hard to get when they are in love. Often, men mistake this love for neediness when in fact you're trying to make the relationship work.

Your instincts are screaming at you to communicate. However, to understand *No Contact* doing exactly the opposite of what you want to do is the best course of action to take. If you were 100% available before, take it down to 20%.

Sherry Argive wrote, "Men don't respond to words they respond to no contact?" Let silence speak volumes for you. Now is the time to let your quiet strength and inner beauty shine. Show him that your life is going forward and functions quite nicely without him. That's when Mr. Ex's head will spin in your direction and he'll begin to seek more attention from you. He'll start to wonder what you're up to for a change instead of the other way around.

This is exactly what you want. You want to change the dynamics of your relationship with him. When he broke up with you, it was his decision that left your heart shattered. You weren't given the opportunity to fix what was broken. But when you take away the emotional control he has over you. *You win.* You now have the opportunity to show him you are no longer his, and when you can do that it puts his Texas size ego in check.

Now is the perfect time to reestablish the life you had before he walked into your

world. Take the time to reflect on the woman you were when the two of you met. If you let yourself go in any way, now is the time to get back to being that woman. Set new, higher goals for yourself and make a plan to accomplish them. That not only elevates your own life to a higher one, but also makes you more attractive to the men around you. And men love women that are constantly trying to better themselves.

CHAPTER TWO

Maybe it's time to get a little pissed off about a man stringing you along for so long.

During the first week take time to mourn the loss of your relationship. It's dead. The relationship as you knew it, is over. Take this time to reflect on how the relationship sailed off course and take ownership of any way in which you contributed to the split

FIND YOUR SOURCE OF COMFORT

One woman told me after her breakup, there were days the only source of comfort was her relationship with God. The only source of comfort was crawling in bed in the fetal position asking God to please wrap his arms around her, give her comfort and strength. Find your source of comfort and look to that source to provide it to you.

The first week of a breakup depending on how fragile you are, you will probably want to crawl in bed. You may have a hard time functioning. The first few days are the hardest, most painful and mind numbing experience you may have ever gone through in your life.

It's perfectly all right to be sad and cry the first few days. You may not want to leave the house. You're entitled to that. You're life has been turned inside out. It takes some women every ounce of energy they can muster up just to find the strength to get up each morning, put a smile on their face and go through the daily grind. They're numb from pain.

Another approach is to be *proactive*. Realize mentally a breakup is going to hurt like hell for a little while. Make up your mind you're not going to let this disable your happiness for the upcoming weeks, months or longer. Call your friends immediately and schedule lunch or even better a night out.

OUT OF SIGHT, OUT OF MIND

There are adjustments you will want to make in your daily life that you grew accustom to when the two of you were a couple. You may have talked on the phone to Mr. Ex, or had conversations through text messages, or phone calls on a daily basis. It's only normal to pray to the phone god that your phone rings every single minute of the day. You want with all of your heart's desire for the message alert to go off. It's the equivalent of, "You've Got Mail."

If you had a special ring tone selected for Mr. Ex now is the time to assign him a new one...preferably a dog bark. Change all of your ring tones so that familiar sound doesn't trigger a memory of him. That way each text message you receive won't bring you disappointment.

The first week will be the perfect time to remove Mr. Ex's photographs and any personal items from sight. Don't be so fast to burn them all, just pack them away for now.

Getting up and dressed will be like a chore you have to force yourself to do. Make a rule before you leave your home that you'll put forth effort to look your best regardless if you want to, or not. Do it as it will make you feel better. And remember this... *Always look hot in case you run in to Mr. Ex!*

Do you remember the scene in *Hope Floats* when Sandra Bullock takes her daughters lunch to school? She was wearing only her pajamas and robe with no make-up, and her hair a mess. Her daughter was humiliated that her mother appeared at school in front of her friends in such a messy state and ignored her. So as hard as it may be you have to get up and get dressed. Don't let anyone see you look like death warmed over. You know you're going through a breakup, but the rest of the world is clueless to this fact. Be the beautiful, unique soul God made you to be. Look beautiful and you'll feel beautiful.

On a calendar, or on your phone mark one week from the date of last contact with Mr. Ex. On day seven reward yourself with anything you want. Make an appointment to get your hair styled, a pedicure and a manicure... (All three never hurt a thing) Lunch with a friend is even better. You may believe you

can't get through these days and I'm not telling you it's going to be a walk in the park, but it is doable. I know it may not seem like it now, but soon you'll look back at this time and think "I can't believe I wasted so much of my time down in the dumps."

Some say to delete Mr. Ex's text messages, emails and voicemails immediately. You know, out of sight-out of mind. I'm going to say keep them and let them serve as a reminder of the pain he may have caused you. And always remember this... *love doesn't hurt*.

Elizabeth wrote after three days of not hearing from her boyfriend of two years he finally sent a text message breaking up with her. She said she wished now she would have never responded, but at the time she was distraught and very emotional. She sent several text messages telling him she loved him and wanted to try to work out any problems they were having. He never responded. She kept those text messages not to revisit the pain, but to let them serve as a reminder that after everything they had shared not only did he end their relationship by text, but also that he couldn't even take the time to reply to one.

Some of the messages and voicemails may bring you a small amount of comfort for the time being. It may be hard to look at an empty inbox. If it makes you feel better keep those old messages and voicemails...for now. You'll know when the time is right to delete them permanently. Use any means necessary to get through this first week. Each week thereafter will get easier.

Continue to set on your calendar a reminder for two weeks of *No Contact*, three, and four and so on. When you're able to check off that you made it through another week without dialing his number you'll feel a sense of pride and accomplishment. Eventually you won't need to set a reminder.

UNDERSTAND WHY YOU'RE TAKING IT SO HARD

One of the major reasons a breakup is hard to go through is because of the loss of feelings associated with being in a relationship. *Being loved*. Everyone wants to feel loved. That feeling doesn't leave just because Mr. Ex did. What so many women confuse is being told they are loved and actually feeling loved. You want to know there is someone in the world that cares for your well-being that cares you're alive and a person you feel connected to.

What makes a breakup hurt so immensely is the feeling of love Mr. Ex gave you, you aren't giving to yourself. The confidence you derived from the feelings of being adored and cherished are no longer your reality.

CHAPTER THREE

THE EMOTIONAL ROLLER COASTER RIDE

If you know in advance the highs, lows, twists and turns of the emotions you're experiencing it makes it a lot easier to handle them. If you anticipate and expect the feelings you are having you'll deal with the array of emotions you're experiencing in a logical way. We only handle unexpected situations poorly because we are simply unprepared.

The most intimate and loving relationships can cause the most emotional turmoil. The range of emotions you experience vary from one hour to the next. You experience fear, sadness, resentment, anger and many other conflicting emotions after a breakup. What's important is that you handle your emotions and not allow them to handle you.

We allow ourselves to be caught up in drama. You're angry with Mr. Ex for not wanting what you want. You feel resentment because you can't verbally express what you need to say. You want clarity and closure, but it never comes. You have to ride this ride with bravery. Putting on a brave face and handling the conflicting emotions you experience takes self-control. When you can take a step back to review your emotions with an outside view you actually turn the emotion from a negative to a positive.

Shock

You may walk around like a robot in a constant state of confusion wondering, "What the hell just happened!" Last week you might have been the happiest person in the world never questioning the future of your relationship. Now you feel like you've been hit by an 18-Wheeler and survived with no broken bones. It may be difficult to talk. I mean literally getting words to come out of your mouth takes effort because it hurts to speak.

People believe they're having a conversation with you, when in reality you're nodding your head pretending to comprehend the conversation. You can barely remember their last name.

You now understand the expression "eating like a bird" because you can barely get down a piece of toast. Your appetite is gone. All you want to do is sleep,

but you can't. Once you finally dose off you wake up in the middle of the night with tears in your eyes. The first question you ask yourself is, "is this real?"

When a breakup occurs unexpectedly it may seem like it's too much to handle. It could last days or even weeks. You'll want to stay in contact with Mr. Ex to avoid facing the reality that life as you knew it, is about to change. *This is the last thing you need to do at this point even though you feel it would provide the most comfort.* It only prolongs the time it takes you to heal. Face the feelings associated with a breakup head on and move forward.

Denial

You're probably questioning your sanity right now, because nothing you have known to be real is. You thought you were in a relationship meant to last. This is the time where controlling your actions and emotions are crucial. Without exercising control you're going to lose the battle of the breakup. You may want to withdraw from friends and family to avoid talking or even acknowledging the breakup.

Realize that everyone has experienced a breakup and will understand what you're going through. What will separate you from so many women is the way you handle it publicly. The best approach when acquaintances ask about it is by simply replying, "It was great while it lasted, but it was simply time to go our separate ways." And they'll respect you for not boring them with insignificant details they could care less about. *Save your venting for close trusted friends only.*

Anger

Chances are you've gone over and over in your mind a hundred times analyzing what exactly went wrong. There were probably red flags waiving like torches of red-hot fire you ignored. Maybe Mr. Ex *never* introduced you to his friends or his family. Did he stop making plans in advance? Did he disappear for weeks at a time only to reappear? Did he start working out? Did he begin to keep long hours at work? Maybe he acted indifferent towards you when you were around each other.

These are huge warning signs he had something, or someone else going on. Now you're not only mad at him, but you're pissed off at yourself for missing those signs. Maybe you ignored them because you believed it was a phase he was going through. It's perfectly normal to feel anger at this point.

Negotiate

This will be the time you want to negotiate to repair the broken relationship. Or, want to know what needed to be fixed to begin with. When something is broken, we normally look to the men in our lives to fix it, but after a breakup we want to dive right into fix it mode because by nature women are nurturers, and want to nurse these problems away with all of our love. You have to refrain from this. A smart woman doesn't negotiate when it comes to matters of the heart. She has a take it or leave it attitude. She doesn't ask to be in a man's life and men love women with this mindset.

You may continually ask yourself what you could have done differently to prevent the breakup from happening. You want to compromise yourself to get the relationship back on track. Repeat after me, "It's not my job to fix this," and don't reach for the phone to do it. Have patience and give yourself time to process the trauma you just went through and wait for him to come to you.

A breakup can bring the strongest of women down. Wanting to call Mr. Ex and send a harmless little text message is going to eat you alive. It's equivalent to a cocaine addict getting his next fix. *Don't do it!* Wait it out. Think long term. If there's a chance of making up you have to sit back and let him come looking for you. Email me, Facebook me, go for a run, go shopping, read a book, meet with friends or watch a movie. Do anything to get your mind off Mr. Ex. But don't touch that phone.

And remember this...When you begin to work overtime to be in a man's life it's because he's not pulling his weight or doing his own fair share of the work. Which is making you work harder. And the harder you work the more he loses respects for you.

Depression

At this point, you'll look back and reminisce about the life you had and what might have been. There will be times you'll be sad and that's perfectly normal. Recognize this for what it is and surround yourself with people that love you. You may not want to get out of bed, but the busier you keep yourself the faster you'll come through to the other side.

Each breakup teaches us something more about ourselves we didn't know. You can look at this time in your life as a growing experience, or you can allow it to disable you for years.

Make the decision to empower yourself to do better and be better than before. You need affection, to feel loved, wanted and needed. Those needs don't change because a relationship didn't work out. You're still alive and your needs still have to be met.

Acceptance

Some argue once it's broken it can't be fixed. I disagree. Throughout history men and women have worked through breakups, struggles, hard times, infidelity and a host of other setbacks. Sometimes they come back stronger and happier than ever. But remember it takes two, to make a relationship work. If both parties are unwilling to put forth the effort you have to be able to recognize this, know when to draw the line in the sand and let go. Have the courage to say enough is enough and move on.

When you can finally let go is when you will be at peace with yourself. And this is usually the time Mr. Ex decides to get his act together. It takes four to eight weeks for a man to realize what he has lost. By that time you may not want him back. Women may take longer to make up their minds, but once we do we stick with it. You'll know you've accepted the breakup when it occurs to you Mr. Ex hasn't entered your mind at all. And it will be sweet.

While you experience all of these emotions sometimes on a day-to-day basis it's hard to resist the temptation to call, or text him at this point. CHAPTER FOUR

Matt LeBlanc once said, "Why do you have to break up with her? Be a man. Just stop calling." But how a man severs his ties is very important and very telling about his character. And remember how a man treats you when no one is watching is the best test you can give a man.

Face to Face

This is a real man with character. In today's high-tech world he's a rare man among men. *He was man enough to tell you in person*. He respected you enough to end the relationship by giving you closure in the best way he could. You won't appreciate a gem like this for a while, but in the end you'll respect this man for having the courage to sit down with you face to face and breaking up with you in a decent manner. A man like this should be admired in today's society where men reduce themselves to boys by breaking up by means of text or email.

Telephone

This is only acceptable in a long distance relationship. Otherwise, it shows he can't handle seeing the look on your face. Not having to face you gives him the courage to breakup.

Email or Text

This is immature, heartless and cold. (*A few other choice words come to mind.*) It says he is a coward and can't face you. He can't even handle a difficult conversation. In short, he doesn't care. Count your blessings this one got away. Don't walk, but run as far away from him as you can.

The Man who Disappears

The Houdini that disappeared without a trace takes the path of least resistance. He doesn't feel the need to explain himself. There are plenty of men that will leave you dangling just to keep you available as an option for another day. If

you've just gone out on a few dates, that's one thing. You don't have a relationship. However, if you've been dating exclusively for three to six months or longer it means he didn't have the spine to tell you you're just not the one for him. Men can't handle tears... it's too much for him. He's not capable of having a hard conversation. He doesn't have a good excuse, so don't waste your time waiting for a bad one. I've heard people say "forgive and forget." Well, if you can't forget how can you ever forgive? If you're struggling with the decision to stick around, or cut him loose ask yourself what kind of affair it was and how you found out? Was it a one-time slip up that he was so riddled with guilt over that he confessed his sin? Were you tipped off by a third-party? Or, was it full-fledged affair that took place over months or even years? Did you have to turn into a female version of Sherlock Holmes to figure out what the hell was going on? Was there premeditated sex? Vacations? Did he take her on business trips to entertain clients, spend time with her family and have preplanned rendezvous?

Because holding on to that baggage can be paralyzing; it can cripple you and keep you from performing in your next encounter. You simply cannot drive forward if you're focused on what's happening in the rearview mirror."

GIVE YOUR HEART TIME TO CATCH UP WITH YOUR BRAIN

If you're still struggling with the decision to stay or go after discovering an affair, realize you may still be in love with him simply because your heart hasn't had time to catch up with your brain. *No contact* is exactly what you need to think with a clear mind. Soon those feelings of love may turn into feelings of nausea when you think of how disrespectful this man has treated you. Cut him loose and don't look back.

WHY YOU CAN'T BE 'JUST FRIENDS'

Sarah Dessen best described why you can't remain friends in her book *This Lullaby* when she wrote, "Because you can never go from going out to being friends, just like that. It's a lie. It's just something that people say they'll do to take the permanence out of a breakup. And someone always takes it to mean more than it does, and then is hurt even more when, inevitably, said 'friendly' relationship is still a major step down from the previous relationship, and it's like breaking up all over again. But messier."

What do you do when a man breaks up, and delivers the "Let's be friends" line? You smile and say, "Sure we can." The next time he calls, or texts...choose the option to ignore him. When he asks you out to dinner, a simple "no thanks" will do.

There is a reason behind the "we can be friends" line when delivered during a breakup that only feeds his ego. It makes him feel like less of an ass than he is. He feels guilty for breaking up, and believes by offering his friendship he is s being a great guy. It's an easy out. Don't blow up when he suggests this. Smile, say "Of course we can," excuse yourself and exit the premises. Disappear from his radar.

Another reason Mr. Ex is asking you to be "just friends" is that he's uncertain if really wants to let you go permanently. He's unsure if you are worth keeping around and wants to explore his options. By asking you to be "just friends" he wants to keep you available as backup in case the other woman, or women on his 'to do' list fail to work out. Forget him and find a man who wants to be your best friend and lover. In a very "friendly" way, move past Mr. Ex quickly.

CHAPTER FIVE

AFTER A BREAKUP, DON'T MAKE THE MISTAKE OF HAVING SEX WITH MR. EX UNTIL HIS ACTIONS PROVE HIS LOVE FOR YOU

No matter how hard you were to get in the beginning of a relationship, never be easy to get after a breakup. It will only lead to him becoming bored once again and will eventually take you for granted. Or worse, he'll view you as a plaything. Men marry women they adore, cherish and the key element that sends a man out to buy the ring: *Respect*. You'll never win him over by being easily seduced, or the girl that drops everything to be with him. And if he doesn't respect you as woman you should just cut your losses now.

Understand that just because Mr. Ex wants to sleep with you does not mean he loves you or is even thinking about a future with you. And it definitely does not mean that he is seeking a reconciliation with you.

WHEN A MAN LOVES A WOMAN

He'll put your feelings above his own. He'll care about you, your family and anything else you consider important. He'll be happy for you when something exciting happens in your life. And will never want to cause you one minute of pain. *It would actually cause him pain to see you hurt*. You'll know without question a man values you, because you'll feel it with every ounce of your being. You won't need to hear his profession of love, because his actions prove it.

You'll never question if he's thinking of you during the day because he constantly communicates by emails, texts messages, phone calls, lunch dates and is making future plans to see you. You'll never question if he has your best interests at heart because you'll never doubt what his motives are.

Steve Harvey described it best in his book *Act Like a Lady, Think Like a Man* when he explained the mindset of a man when it comes to loving the woman he is committed to. The three "P's" that make up the DNA of a man. Profess. Provide. Protect. When a man loves you, he'll profess his love. Meaning he will always introduce you as his lady, girlfriend, wife or significant other. A man will always protect you to make sure that no harm will come your way emotionally or physically. Last but not least, a man that loves and cares for you will provide for you in whatever capacity he can.

NO MAN'S AFRAID OF A LITTLE CONFLICT

Arguments and disagreements not only test a relationship, but also show you how strong one is. If he's not willing to have a hard conversation with you to work out conflicts then cut him off and move on. You want a man that is a rock of strength, not one that vanishes at the first sign of trouble. Relationships take two people willing to occasionally set their pride aside and admit when they're wrong, or that they have made a mistake.

If a man breaks up with you for any reason, or disappears for a week or longer you need to really step back and look at the relationship for what it is. This means if he tells you he needs time to think about what he wants, or the worst... when he just falls off the face of the earth without giving an explanation... you need to cut him off and disappear! To take you seriously he has to put you in a different category than he does the other women on his rotation. And in order for him to view you differently he has to know without doubt you'll kick him to curb at the first sign of disrespect.

(Now, I'm not talking about the guy you went out with a few times and he never called you again. I'm talking about the man you had a real relationship with. The man you believed you would spend the rest of your life with.)

Let's say a man told you he needed time to sort out his feelings. Turn the tables on him so to speak. When he resurfaces let it be a few weeks before he can find you. Men know they are supposed to place a phone call!

If you've been intimate with him and he goes silent, the smart girl doesn't give him a second chance. There's no excuse for it. These men know they're screwing up. Make it clear to him you expect a man to be present in your life. If he can't handle that, don't only show him the door, open it wide enough so he can easily walk through it. And guess what, you'll earn his admiration for doing this and at the same time, protect your heart. It's a win, win.

Let him know from the beginning he walked out on the relationship and you have no time for a man that treats your life like a revolving door. When you put your foot down you'll earn his respect. And when you earn a man's respect,

you'll have him right where he belongs...wrapped around your little finger.

Always remember that 'a monkey knows what trees he can climb'. When you **ignore** a man's blatant disrespect it only guarantees it will continue. You need not tell him that he has to work for you, but don't make it easy for him. Continue to move forward with your life without skipping a beat.

Before you offer your heart again make sure he's passing your tests. Make sure his actions are proving his love to you... not his words.

KNOW WHEN TO CUT THE STRINGS

- Don't settle for an on again off again relationship. It's unhealthy and will only make your happiness feel like a roller coaster ride with highs, lows, ups and downs. You deserve better!
- Just like small children men will test you to see what they can get away with. Standing your ground, holding on to your own beliefs, convictions and knowing when your kindness is being taken for granted will earn his respect.
- You must constantly evaluate your relationship and ask yourself if you're getting what you want and need out of it. Identify your needs. Do you need more affection? Attention? Security? Companionship? More sex? If you're not getting what you need you won't be happy. If you've nicely told him what your needs are and he doesn't step up to meet them, know that it's time to move on. Don't settle for a man that isn't meeting all of your needs.

IS HE STRINGING YOU ALONG?

There are men that simply don't know what they want. If that's the case know you are not in his life to fix any unresolved issues he may have. Let another woman waste her time.

If he's stringing you along, don't fool yourself by believing you can change him. Only he can make the necessary changes in his life. When you decide to completely cut him off he'll either decide to make those changes or he won't. If he doesn't step up for you, accept the fact that you have dodged a bullet and be thankful you didn't allow him to waste anymore of your precious time.

Some men simply don't deserve a second chance and you may have given him twenty. Know you deserve the best a man has to offer and refuse to settle for crumbs. If Mr. Ex is keeping you on the fence now would be a great time to tell him he knows your number and you hope he calls when he figures out what he wants out of life. In the mean time you won't be waiting for him. Your next move is to let your actions speak louder than any words you could ever communicate and go completely silent. Adopt this old saying and repeat it to

yourself every day, "Men are like trains, one comes by every five minutes."

You must understand you'll never be able to move on in love if you continue to stay in touch with Mr. Ex. Only when you emotionally detach yourself will you be available, open and ready for love with Mr. Right. When you're thinking with your heart and not your mind you don't make solid, clear choices.

Jackie Mason said, "Eighty percent of married men cheat in America. The rest cheat in Europe." And chances are Mr. Ex lives in America. He may just be selfish and want his cake in one hand, ice cream in the other and you sitting there feeding it to him with a silver spoon. Do not under any circumstances compete for his love with another woman. When you compete you demean yourself. And it sends a loud and clear message of desperation. He may have two women who provide him with and fulfill different needs of his own. Regardless of how well the two of you meshed accept the fact you'll never be able to make him happy. Move on to someone who will make his mission in life to keep you happy and satisfied. Love yourself enough to move on. Keep him on the *ex-list* forever.

INTUITION...A GIRLS BEST FRIEND

That indescribable feeling you get that says "Something's not quite right here." It's been referred to as a whisper from God. Listen to it, trust it and let it be your best friend. Kim Basinger said "I feel there are two people inside me - me and my intuition. If I go against her, she'll screw me every time, and if I follow her, we get along quite nicely.

There is nothing stronger or more powerful than a woman's intuition. Unfortunately, many women confuse intuition with insecurities. Especially when it comes to matters of the heart. This is the time when you need to trust your intuition the most. If you believe you're being insecure, maybe a good question to ask yourself is "What am I being insecure about?" Your intuition will tell you something is wrong, but it's your job to determine what it is. Whether a man is lying, cheating or maybe you just feel he doesn't have your best interests at heart. Whatever the case may be find the underlying cause of it.

You may have heard the old expression "Idle hands are the devils workshop." The same is true if think and obsess over Mr. Ex. Keep your mind and body busy to avoid allowing emotions to override your logic and do anything drastic. Think about the future. What do you think Mr. Ex will have to say about you while enjoying dinner with his friends or family? Will you be the crazy girl that wouldn't go away? Or, will you be the one he regrets losing?

So let's look at some of the drastic measures women will take to get attention after a breakup. Make a promise to yourself you won't be "that girl."

Sending endless text messages. You want Mr. Ex to know how you feel and to understand how much pain you're experiencing. You want him to know without a doubt you love him and how much you're hurting. You believe by conveying this information to him, he'll come back to you. *You're wrong!* The only message you're sending to Mr. Ex is you are going a little crazy. And he's eating it up. He's looking at his phone blowing up and thinking, "I can't believe she's falling apart like this." Again, you're feeding his super-size ego. It's a fact men and women are usually within three feet of their cell phone. He received your message! A good rule to live by is if you send a text message and receive no response--you should never send a second one. Ask yourself this question "What good would a text do anyway?" Real relationships require face-to-face conversations during conflict, not text messages. Conversations through text messages are for teenagers.

The Accidental Text. He knows the accidental text ploy. No "accidentally" sending a text message to him by mistake to later claim it was intended for your sisters-cousins, best friends-brother. No nothing. Silence.

Calling repeatedly. If you dial his number know in advance Mr. Ex is going to hit the option to ignore your call. If he does answer chances are you'll let your emotions take over and trust me, nothing good or productive will come from a heated exchange. When you're under a great deal of emotional stress the more likely you are to say words you really don't mean and will ultimately regret. Besides, Mr. Ex will have nothing to say that can or will bring you the closure you need. If he ignores your call, it's just going to rip your heart out all over again. No calling by mistake, delete his number, block his number if you must or sit on your hands, read a book, go for a jog, or email me! *Do anything but dial his number!*

Begging/pleading with Mr. Ex to take you back. Would you

date a man who cried, begged and pleaded for you to date him? *No*, *I didn't think so*. It would make him appear desperate and pathetic, right? Desperate and pathetic is the exact image you're portraying to him if you call, text or show up at his house without an invitation in a drunken stupor sobbing "*I can't live without you*." Have some pride and know the value you bring to a relationship. Again, think long term, not short term satisfaction. You want to be the woman of his dreams and I can assure you the woman of his dreams isn't a woman who is a complete mess.

Blocking your number, calling and hanging up. Mr. Ex knows it's you calling. Stop it! No attempts to contact him whatsoever. It's creepy and falls under harassment.

Driving by his house. Unless you live next door there's really no excuse for driving by his home. It falls under stalker/harassing behavior. Most men and women consider this a major turn off (and illegal).

Frequenting places you know he'll be. If you work together there's really nothing you can do, but try to avoid him at all costs. If you frequented the same places find another place to frequent. Right now you need to be scarce. If you have children together the same applies. Deal with the issues at hand in a calm, mature manner and find your exit as quickly as possible.

Sending emails. No desperately seeking closure emails. No "Hi, how are you?" No wishing him a Merry Christmas, Happy New Year or Happy Birthday. Not a peep!

Letting him know you're falling apart. A man doesn't take a woman back because she confessed she couldn't live without him. This cries out "desperation" and you won't be an exception. Have some pride and know that what is attractive to a man is a woman who is independent and self-sufficient.

Cursing, telling him he'll never find anyone better. First, it's

just not pretty and if you do this he'll make a point to find someone better. And you're only showing your ass. Again, think long term. Think back to what made him fall in love with you to begin with and be *that woman*.

Cyber Stalking. This is a tough one that requires massive self-control. Why? Because it's right there... *at your manicured fingertips!* What your ex does from this point on is none of your concern. Ask yourself if you really want to know what new girls appear as his friends or followers. This will only hurt you in the end and make you a little crazy along the way. Block him. Delete him. Do whatever you have to do, but do yourself a favor and refrain from becoming obsessed with his social networking activity.

Dealing with friends and family. If you had the same friends by all means remain friends, just remember they are his friends also. When you run in to them make small talk and be on your way. No bashing Mr. Ex. Don't even mention his name. Only if they bring him up in conversation should you reply with something complimentary about him. No tears or breakdowns. Do nothing that would give the impression you're allowing this breakup to bring you down. Put on a performance that would make Glenn Close green with envy.

Attempting to make Mr. Ex jealous. Mr. Ex will see any attempts to make him jealous as the desperate-attention-seeking methods they truly are. Right now is not the time for this type of behavior and he won't find it attractive. Don't go out to rub it in his face. Rather, go out to enjoy yourself and to move on. **Don't** act as if you have a full life, actually have a full life.

Don't look desperate on Social Media Sites. Look at what you posted in the previous two months prior to the breakup. That's what you should continue to post. Nothing out of the ordinary that makes you appear as if you're grasping for attention. Post what you normally post and avoid pictures of you out partying until four o'clock in the morning. The same applies to posting sad, depressing

expressions of love. Your friends don't want to get depressed on a social networking site. Don't check-in to every nightclub. Continue to be the beautiful, respectful, fun woman he fell in love with. Any attempts to get his attention during this time will only backfire and make you look a mess.

No ex sex. If sex was what tied relationships together everyone would be blissfully married. Sex didn't prevent him from breaking up with you, sex didn't keep him by your side and sex is not going to make him come back to you now. I don't care how sad he sounds or how much he tells you he misses you. No sex before monogamy. If he just broke up with you it's safe to assume you're no longer in a monogamous relationship. To have sex with you again he needs to prove his love for you.

Imagine how constantly calling, sending text messages or accidentally running into him will make you look. It will mortify him and he'll mentally file in you the 'crazy' category.

You may also believe a friendly harmless text message to Mr. Ex just to remind him you are still out in the world will do no harm and will actually remind him of all the warm fuzzy feelings the two of you once shared. Let me assure you that Mr. Ex knows where you are and how to find you. There's no need to send a reminder and if he needs a reminder to call you, do you really want him anyway?

Understand that there is really nothing that will keep a man away from a woman he loves. He has the same means of communication you have. He still has your number. Don't fool yourself to believe sending a pointless text message will magically make him come running in your direction.

You may very well be pursing Mr. Ex after the breakup and not even realize it. You may be seeking closure in an attempt to save the broken relationship. It's very likely towards the end of the relationship; Mr. Ex began to detach himself emotionally. Chances are he stopped initiating calls, texts and stopped making plans in advance. Some of the signs that you may have been pursing him include, but are not limited to calling him, texting, emailing, making arrangements for a date night or just to see him. In our modern society we often forget it's a man's job to do everything in his power to make us happy. Not the other way around. And when a man loves you, he is going to want to see you. You won't have to remind him to call, plan lunch or dinner dates because he'll be one step ahead of the game.

The list could go on and on. Understand every single action you take will be viewed as a sign of desperation and neediness and is massaging his ego. And the second you start compromising for the sake of massaging a man's ego, that's it, game over.

Your only job is to show him you can live without him. Show him you don't need him and you might be surprised how fast he comes looking for you. Most importantly -- *make your exit with class, dignity and pride intact.*

HANDLING A BREAKUP THROUGH FACEBOOK AND TWITTER

He can't possibly experience what life is like without you if he sees your pretty face in a post or tweet every day. Nor will he feel the need to call if all he has to do is logon on to the nearest computer to find out what you're doing, how you're feeling and where you're going. You're taking away any incentive he has to actually pick up the phone and find out.

The second question is:

"How do I face my six hundred and fifty-eight friends and followers right in the middle of a breakup?" Look at it this way... You and Mr. Ex are the only two people on God's green earth that currently know you are going through a breakup. (Along with a few friends you're depending on for the emotional support you need.) The smart girl quietly takes down any photographs (especially profile pictures that include Mr. Ex). Or she moves them to an album where privacy settings are set to private. Making a public announcement is not required or necessary. Just as you phased him in your life, phase him out. When you ask yourself how long you should wait before contacting Mr. Ex, one of the best rules to live by is this...Don't contact a man to begin with. Why? Learn a lesson from Hanna who sent a little text message to John, the man who broke up with her unexpectedly. Three weeks after the breakup she was still devastated. Against her better judgment, she sent him a text message just to say she was thinking of him. John responded, which thrilled Hanna. Another three days went by and he sent her another text. Hanna was elated John was showing

signs of interest again. Things progressed and they saw each other the following weekend and he continued to call and acted as if nothing ever happened. She believed he just needed space. That is until the other woman he had begun to date that lived out of town had a free weekend without her kids. John was using two women to keep his time occupied.

I've taken a brutally honest excerpt from Greg Behrendt and Amiira Ruotola Behrendts book *It's Called a Breakup, Because It's Broken*, which sums it up pretty accurately as to why a man's not calling. "If he's not calling you, it's because you are not on his mind. If he creates expectations for you, and then doesn't follow through on little things, he will do same for big things. Be aware of this and realize that he's okay with disappointing you. Don't be with someone who doesn't do what they say they're going to do. If he's choosing not to make a simple effort that would put you at ease and bring harmony to a recurring fight, then he doesn't respect your feelings and needs. "Busy" is another word for "asshole." "Asshole" is another word for the guy you're dating. You deserve a fucking phone call."

Men don't need a reminder to call you! Have a sense of pride and self-respect. And know if he's not dialing your number, he's not worthy of your time. Don't subject yourself to being treated poorly and know that if you're unhappy in anyway, then he's not treating you the way you deserve. If you're the one making phone calls it sends a message to a man that you're insecure, needy and that you don't have other options. And maybe you don't... but he doesn't have to know this information. Imagine him looking at his phone with a grin that would make the Joker look bashful. He's thinking to himself, "I've got this one on the hook." If he's interested in you, he won't make you feel like an option.

Immediately start working to enhance your own life. Focus on elevating your life to a higher one. By not losing your cool after a breakup, knowing you handled the situation with grace, class and dignity will give your confidence a tremendous boost and more importantly, you demonstrate with your actions that you're a woman with self control. And when he knows you can handle yourself it raises your value.

When you choose to start *No Contact*, it may seem you're defeating your purpose if your purpose is to see Mr. Ex again. Women tend to want instant

gratification and taking two months of your life to accomplish that seems drastic. Remember it's not about an immediate fix. It's about creating a long-term relationship and taking time to gain the insight and clarity you need to fix a broken relationship, or move past a bad one. When you make your mind up that you can be upbeat regardless of what life throws at you, that's empowerment.

It's only natural for you to want the one person that hurt you to hold you in their arms and give you the reassurance you need that all will be fine. More importantly you want him to stop this foolish behavior and just fix the breakup! Its unfortunate breakups just don't work like that, but you have to have a clear understanding that if a man isn't contributing his fifty percent to make the relationship work, then you need to make him feel that you are losing interest and drop out of sight.

When you take time to compose yourself after a breakup you can be assured that if you hold it together, behave in such a way and get your emotions in check you'll be able to communicate with clarity when Mr. Ex does call. Change your mindset and the atmosphere around you with your attitude. Tell yourself every day:

I love myself.
I believe in myself.
I am capable of achieving any goal I set.
I shine.
I feel great.
I look great.
Today will be an awesome day!

Write it down, place it in a drawer you open every morning so it's the first thing you see. If you say it to yourself, you'll believe in yourself. Make a point each day to let the best of you reflect outwardly to everyone you come in contact with. With consistency you'll become the woman everyone notices.

DIVE INTO THE DATING POOL

The biggest mistake women make is by devoting all of their time and attention to one man that isn't in return devoting all of *his* time and attention to her. You may feel bad about dating more than one man, but don't. Men do this all the time. They're just experts when it comes to hiding it. Men want sex, women want security. Until a man is providing you with security along with anything else you want, don't provide him with an exclusive relationship with sex. It's that simple. If a man likes you...*really likes you*, he'll make it clear he doesn't want you to continue dating other men.

Acknowledge and understand that life as you knew it is over with Mr. Ex. You're a single woman that's free to date any man you so desire. And as long as you're not sleeping with every guy you date (*unless you want to*) it's perfectly fine to move forward dating without guilt. Keep your options open even if Mr. Ex comes back in the picture. This will give him a little reminder that he's not the only fish in the sea and makes you more attractive at the same time.

When you learn how to date several men it does nothing but sky rockets your self-confidence, because choosing who you want to spend your time becomes more like selecting the right pair of shoes for the perfect dress. It puts you back in the position of selector instead of the chaser. It fills up your calendar where you're no longer waiting on one man to call, because you have many men to keep you occupied. You change your position from needing someone, to being wanted by someone. Keep at least three to four men in the dating pool regardless if you like one more than the other. And until the man you're in love with slides an engagement ring on your little finger, keep your options open.

Be Mysterious --

Men love a woman that is a little elusive and hard to figure out. Why? Because it intrigues him and leaves him craving more. And after a breakup, becoming a mystery can be attractive and a challenge. If you've played by the rules and not called or text, Mr. Ex will eventually call because 'curiosity kills the cat'. He'll eventually want to know what's going on in your life and more importantly, why you're not calling. When he does call let it go directly to voicemail. After the

third or fourth attempt he makes, respond to one. If by phone be polite but don't offer too much information and be the first to end the conversation. If by text, again be polite, but vague. And whatever you do, don't start off by telling him how much you've missed him and can't wait to see him again. If you run into him at a social function be polite and make your exit first. Again, leave him wondering and guessing where you're going and what you've been up to.

The Biggest Attraction Killer

If you want to see a man run like a professional athlete...be needy. *There's nothing more unattractive to a man than a needy, clingy woman.* A man wants to feel needed and appreciated, but he doesn't want to feel as if your life and happiness depends on him. If you notice yourself doing any of the following, realize you may have too much time on your hands and start finding ways to occupy your time.

Signs you may be acting a little too needy

- · You feel the need to stay in constant contact to know where he is at all times.
- You seek out attention.
- · You constantly worry about being dumped.
- · You're always available, even cancelling your own plans to be with him.
- You do whatever he wants.
- · You try to make him feel guilty that he's not doing everything you want to do.
- · You sulk if he doesn't give all of his attention to you · You create drama.

Any sign of neediness, drama or desperation kills the attraction a man has for you faster than turning off a light switch. It screams "Something is wrong with me!" The same is true for a woman who allows a man to walk on her like a treadmill. Men don't find doormats or pushovers attractive. Know your value and understand the qualities you bring to a relationship. Show him that you are a woman of substance.

CHAPTER ELEVEN

HOW TO MAKE MR. EX MISS YOU

Helen Rowland once said, "A man is like a cat; chase him and he will run. Sit still and ignore him and he'll come purring at your feet." It's really that simple. We as women make it complicated because it goes against every fiber of our being to ignore someone. We think it's rude, or assume a man will think we're being mean if we don't respond.

Think about how you feel when you're being ignored. You immediately panic and start to worry you've done something wrong. And that's exactly what he'll do if you push his emotional hot buttons. It shatters his fragile ego. And don't think that because you don't return a phone call, or ignore a text it will deter his efforts. The harder it is to win you over the more exhilarating the victory is for him in the end.

By giving Mr. Ex space, and more importantly silence...you transfer those feelings of loss, rejection and abandonment that he placed on you, right back to him. Often men fail to realize what they have until it is gone and it's your job to make him realize what he's lost.

As I mentioned before, after a breakup Mr. Ex is expecting you to call him crying, drowning in your sorrows, in a state of depression, groveling and pleading with him to take you back. He's expecting the drama show you provide to be better than the Super bowl half-time entertainment. When you do the exact opposite of what he's expecting it throws a kink in his rope and he'll soon begin to second-guess himself. He thinks, "Wait. What just happened? Shouldn't she be calling by now?" A top-notch man wants a top-notch woman that can handle her emotions and when you demonstrate you can handle your emotions you become the woman with the Midas touch.

Only when you go silent and *ignore* him will he begin to wonder what you're doing. Think back to the thoughts going through your mind. Do you wonder what he's doing? With whom is he doing it with? He'll begin to ask himself the same questions if you give him a chance.

Only when you keep your distance and avoid him at all costs will he begin to migrate back to you, but first you have to be patient and give him time to get that place. And he'll never miss you if you are constantly in his face, or trying to stay in touch with him.

Nor will he have the opportunity to wonder why you're not calling, working your fingers to the bone dialing his number in an effort to salvage the tattered relationship. Mr. Ex's imagination will go wild when he starts to think about another man making you happy. He'll begin to believe you've moved on and start to ask himself if you ever had feelings for him to begin with.

When you *respond* to calls and text messages from Mr. Ex after a breakup, you're giving him attention that feeds his fragile ego. When you give him attention you believe it's the right thing to do, because it feels good to hear his voice and it gives him attention, which is what a woman likes. It makes *you* feel wanted because he's still keeping the lines of communication open. But it does exactly the opposite for men.

When you give Mr. Ex attention after a breakup it's too much, too soon. You'll never hear a man say, "I broke up with my girlfriend last week, but since then she's been really sweet. She calls and texts me throughout the day to let me know she cares, and just today I received a dozen long stem red roses. She even offered to come by and clean my house. I think I made a mistake and should give her another chance." No... he'll run faster than a gazelle with a lion on its tail (after you have cleaned his house) and he'll mentally file you under 'psychotic and obsessed.'

On the other hand when you go silent and let calls go directly to voicemail, he gets interested again because you appear to be a bit out of reach and more of a challenge. And a challenge triggers the attraction mechanism in the alpha male. They just can't say *no* to a challenge...It's not in their DNA.

That's when Mr. Ex says, "I don't want to lose her, so I'd better do something before some other man does." The more he's unable to read your emotions the harder he'll try and the more he'll want you.

For every three to four attempts he makes to contact you only reply to one. Don't mention the breakup and don't mention how lousy you're feeling. Keep the conversation light and breezy and be the first one to end the conversation. Try to keep conversations by phone to no more than five minutes. Remember that hard conversations are meant to take place face to face and if he's not verbally planning a time when he can find out what he has to do to make your relationship work, then go back to *no contact*. Only when he's making plans to see you and his actions are proving his love for you should you begin to show signs of interest again.

If you're giving too much

Take a step back by throwing all of your time, effort and attention into work, hobbies and making dates with yourself and others to keep busy. Have plans set a week in advance. Every Sunday, sit down and plan the week ahead. Even if your plan is with a DVD, the couch and wearing nothing more than your pajamas. You'll look forward to it when you plan for it.

Each passing day the urge to contact him will become less of a chore and more of an accomplishment. Carry on with your life as you did prior to meeting him and prove to him (and yourself) that you're independent and perfectly capable of having a life of your own. A woman in control of her emotions appeals to a man. Men want you to depend on them and that's fine if he's doing his part, but remember he has to prove to you he can be depended on. You'll earn his respect if you raise the bar and set your standards high.

It takes four to eight weeks for a man to really experience the absence of your presence and realize that he may lose you for good. At the beginning of a breakup it's an understandable impulse for women to want to find out what went wrong, but know that most men agree that you shouldn't do a thing to get their attention. They will also tell you that you should cease all contact to shake things up a bit. So do exactly the opposite of what you want to do. This is why it's essential for you to completely break off contact. You have to take time to think with a clear head. If you don't give him the opportunity to experience what life is like without you, and make him believe you've moved on, he'll never come back to you.

TO BE ON MR. EX'S MIND

You have to make him think of you constantly. Just as playing hard to get, or actually *being hard to get* (which is much better) created an intense attraction between the two of you in the beginning, it will do the same now.

Give a little and then pull back. Carry on with your life as if there were no interruption. Don't worry he'll believe you're not interested and then be gone for good. Have faith in yourself that you're worth the effort. If a man gives up on love that easily then he wasn't really worth your time to begin with.

When you keep him guessing, it keeps him interested. Think about Kate Middleton. After patiently waiting for years for Prince William to propose, he broke up with her. Can you imagine her devastation? Reports were that she was beside herself with grief. Privately I'll bet she went to pieces, but publicly she never looked better. Within a month after the breakup

she began working out and got in the best shape of her life. She became a social butterfly hosting charity events and was seen out and about enjoying the nightlife. Look at where that got her.

You may not have photographers waiting to snap pictures of your every move, but you do have the power of social media... *Use it wisely*.

A sure way to lose happiness, I found, is to want it at the expense of everything else.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Question: I need to return a razor, toothbrush, and some personal items to Mr. Ex. Should I call or send him a text to make arrangements?

Answer: No. You need to place said items in the garbage. Personal items that can easily be replaced should be discarded. No further thought is required. Personal belongings of substantial value should be neatly packed in a boxed and shipped to his home address. No note. No card. Mr. Ex is anticipating opening said box to see a sappy love note begging him to come back to you. Deprive his ego and make him wonder what your intent was. If Mr. Ex insists on swinging by your house to pick up any items he's left at your place, tell him you'll be happy to leave a box with (neatly packed items) by your front door. No need to ring the doorbell. Make sure you're out shopping or visiting friends.

Question: I need to return his house key. Should I call, or send a text to make arrangements for delivery?

Answer: No. Place key in an envelope and mail it to him. Make any arrangements you need to get Mr. Ex that key without coming into contact with him. Don't waste your time preparing a card or note to go along with the key. If he has half of a brain, when he opens the envelope he'll know that it's his house key.

Question: I left my facial crème at his house. Should I drop by to pick it up?

Answer: Not unless you paid three-hundred dollars for it, there's a full jar and it was imported from England. Even in that case if you can afford to buy facial cream for three-hundred dollars chances are you can afford another jar. Go to the drug store and buy more!

Question: We have children together. How do I start the no contact rule?

Answer: You don't. You have to communicate where the children are concerned. However, the children are the only topic you need to communicate about. Keep communication short, sweet and to the point.

Question: It's his birthday. Should I send him a Happy Birthday text?

Answer: No. He'll remember who *did not* send him birthday wishes longer than

he'll remember who did.

Question: What about Christmas. Should I send him a friendly Merry Christmas text?

Answer: No. If Mr. Ex wishes you one you should reply but only match the vibe he's sending. For example, if you receive a 'Merry Christmas' text. You would reply 'And one to you.' Wait at least three hours before replying. If he sends the text after eight o'clock in the evening wait until the next day to reply. Resume no contact.

If he asks you out on Valentine's Day for dinner that night you have to nicely reply "Have plans, perhaps some other time." I know this is hard to do especially if your only plans are to sit at home alone with your dog to watch Grey's Anatomy. Know that if he really wanted to wine and dine you for Valentines he would have planned for this night well in advance.

I hope you understand my point. You shouldn't contact him in any form or fashion. The only time it's acceptable to break *No Contact* is if he's your next-door neighbor and you notice fire blazing from the windows of his house. It's perfectly acceptable to break *No Contact* at that time. *Don't get any ideas!*

BREAKUP RULES TO LIVE BY

Don't try to remain friends.

Don't initiate contact with Mr. Ex.

Don't try to change his mind, beg, plead or cry in front of him.

Don't frequent places you know he'll be.

Don't try to resolve problems by telephone or text messages. (Remember real conversations require eye contact)

Don't answer every time he calls. For every three attempts he makes only respond to one.

Don't respond to 'nothing' text messages.

Don't ask him for a date; wait for him to ask you. If he doesn't ask you, know he's not interested.

Don't agree to last minute dates. If he asks to meet that day, tell him you would love to, but can't. Make a suggestion for at least three days later, or the next week.

Don't answer the phone or texts after seven o'clock p.m.

Don't answer the phone or texts during weekends.

Don't invite him to your home or drive to his.

Don't accept last minute dates. If he's not planning dates accept he's not interested.

Don't compete with other women.

Don't date him if he doesn't meet your requirements.

Don't rush into sex.

Do get back to being the woman Mr. Ex fell in love with (only better.) *Do* return items of his that need to be returned quickly (See FAQ's) *Do* plan your week, a week in advance and keep occupied.

Do make a list of requirements you must have in a relationship.

Do take time to heal.

Do rely on friends during this time.

Do remember to always look your best. Do start dating new men, regardless if you want to or not. Do learn to love the chase.

Do love yourself ...

And always, always be classy!
