

## Sidewalk Chalk

### Ingredients:

- 6 eggshells (saved from eggs you've eaten)
- 1 tsp. flour
- 1 tsp. very hot tap water
- clean, smooth rock
- 2 small dishes
- spoon
- strip of paper towel

### Instructions:

Wash and dry the eggshells. Grind them outdoors on clean, smooth concrete with a clean, smooth rock. Grind and grind until you get fine eggshell powder. Sweep it up with your hands and put it into a dish. Pick out any big pieces of eggshell and throw them away. Measure the flour and hot water into another dish. Stir until you get a paste. Add 1 T. of the eggshell powder. Mix and mash until it all sticks together. Shape and press the mixture firmly into a chalk stick. Roll it up tight in a strip of paper towel. Let it dry for 3 days. Your sidewalk chalk will get rock hard. Tear the paper off one end. Write with the chalk, erase with your shoe. Sidewalk chalk is for sidewalks, not blackboards.
